SUMMARY

Requires Department of Human Services to study and report on to interim committees of Legislative Assembly, no later than September 20, 2020, projected need for and projected supply of memory care facilities in 2030.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to memory care facilities.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. No later than September 20, 2020, the Department of Human Services shall research and report on, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to health, in the manner provided in ORS 192.245, the projected demand in this state for beds at memory care facilities in 2030 and the projected supply of memory care facilities to meet the need. If the department concludes that the projected demand will exceed the projected supply, the department may recommend legislative changes necessary to facilitate an increase in the supply of memory care facilities or other alternatives, including increasing the capacity of community-based services.
