

Dear Committee,

I strongly oppose HB 3063 which will take away non-medical exemptions from Oregon parents. As a future parent, aunt & care taker or children, I simply do not believe a child should be excluded from schools because the parent chooses to exempt their child from one or more vaccines due to religious or philosophical reasons. I don't believe we have the right to take away anyone's ability to make decisions for their own body or the body of their child.

Even though I am supportive of people opting-in to get their kids vaccinated; this is a bad bill! Most parents aren't anti-vax, just pro choice. State-wide, the vaccine opt-out rate is only 2.5%
Removing the ability for children to opt out of vaccines even when recommended to do so by a
