I opposed HB 3063 and I do not believe a child should be excluded from schools because of parent chooses to exempt their child for one or more of vaccines due to religious or philosophical reasons. Please, please vote NO on HB 3063

Forcing vaccinations can cause mistrust between parents and doctors. This leads to such a greater mistrust with our own government as well as upcoming medicines that could potentially help us and shape our future. Depriving a child of Education because parents will not comply to regulations that have no real statistical or medical backing on the effectiveness and have been proven to fail time and time again. Not only is this un American and unconstitutional to force parents into a position where they have to comply with regulations and put trust in something that has not only injured hundreds of thousands of children. This is unethical on multiple levels. Statistically only a rough 1% know that their child will have a negative reaction to a vaccine, and most are uninformed on this topic completely. As of March 31st 2018 there have been more than 89,355 reports of the measles vaccine reactions and hospitalizations, injuries and death following the measles vaccinations made to the federal vaccine adverse events reporting system (VAERS), including 445 related deaths 6,196 hospitalizeations and 1,657 related disabilities. Over 60 percent of those adverse events occurred in children 3 years old and under. Not only are you forcing us to contaminate our children with human fetal cell DNA that for some reason other countries can manufacturer without that but we in the US cannot. This goes against so many codes of ethics not only philosophical but religious exemption. This goes against our first amendment this is also reflected the title VII of the Civil rights Act of 1964 as amended November 1st 1980 Parts 1605.1guidelines on discrimination because of religion.

All of the facts and links that I will list below make it clear that discrimination in a Public School setting against children not vaccinated for reasons of conscience is completely unwarranted as the vaccine status consciousness objectors proses no undue risk to the public.

The chances of an infant Contracting measles is close to 1: 1,000,000 and most is from international travel. Declaring this a state of emergency and fast-tracking this bill is not showing us that we can trust our rights for education on the topic, when this is far from an emergency. Immunologist's have proven that unvaccinated children do not pose a threat in our community to say otherwise is naive and untrue. This can be backed by statistical experimentation and years of medical research. within vaccinations there is a population called Low-responders, individuals with a week immune response to subsequent re-vaccination these people quickly return to the pool of "susceptibles" within 2 to 5 years even though they are fully vaccinated they responded poorly to the first measles vaccinations. This is to be a genetic trate finding it cannot be corrected with re-vaccination, and the proportion of low responder among children were estimated to be 4.7% in the US. \*The studies found in China and Quebec Canada show outbreaks of measles will still happen even when vaccination compliant is at the highest bracket between 95% and 97% even 99% because even the high vaccine responder vaccine induced antibodies wane overtime. So in summary, outbreaks of measles cannot be entirely prevented even if we had nearly perfect vaccination compliance.

If vaccines were effective there would be no reason to mandate them in general. Unvaccinated children pose no risk to community, many worldwide studies have proven this. Due to the properties of modern vaccines non vaccinated individuals pose no greater risk of the transmissions of polio, diptheria, pertussis and numerous other non type b H. Influenzae strains that vaccinated individuals do.

The effectiveness of the measles vaccine and specifically how it works has been disproven by Harvard University immunologist explained thoroughly in the link below. This is reason alone to throw out this bill. Many scientists back this and the list is growing.
