Good day folks,

I'll make my plea brief. 16 years ago, I had a tumultuous pregnancy with 2 precious boys. At 27 weeks, they both came into this world. Beautiful, but not ready. 10 days later, my son Tristan died in my hands from pulmonary failure and a brain bleed. My son Keegan fought like a lion! His prognosis wasn't that much brighter than his brother's, yet 2 full months into his life, we got to take him home.

Home for us was a temporary room on Lester Naval Base in Okinawa. We were there for the NICU. My husband was stationed at Misawa AFB. I still had to make the trek with Keegan back to northern Japan and eventually back to the states. Even after all that my son had endured, at every appt we went to, they kept saying that we needed to get his vaccinations done. All I wanted to do was to hold on to my one son that had survived, so of course I complied.

Keegan was happy, sweet, content and quite healthy, although he was always about a month behind on development. Yet it wasn't until we took him in for his 2 year shots that we saw him take such a dramatic turn. We went in one week for his MMR and the nurse told us to come back a week later to get a Prevnar shot. We did, at which time they gave Keegan a second MMR shot in addition to the Prevnar. By that night, he was completely lethargic, crying inconsolably, and stopped eating. We gave him Tylenol as the nurse prescribed, which only seemed to make him worse. Over the next few weeks Keegan began to seem very lost in his own world, got a "cold" that just never seemed to go away, began rocking himself and any language he had seemed to disappear. He was diagnosed with autism at 2 1/2.

Now I am NOT against vaccinations, but I do believe that not every child should be on the same schedule. After everything his little body had gone through, he did not have the capacity to keep filtering all that garbage through his system without damage and injury. I also believe that if you expect a more educated society to accept the ingredients in vaccinations, those vaccinations need a serious overhaul in purity. 3/4 of the US population identified as Christian. Aborted fetal cells and animal cells have to go if you plan to make vaccinations mandatory, otherwise you are violating the First Amendment for 75% of the American people. Can't do this folks.

Figure out a better way, a better schedule, better ingredients, safer for our kids, in compliance with our Constitution.
