>>> neurotoxins and are injected

> (cellular

>>> cellular immunity. Vaccines
> only
>> stimulate the humoral Th2
>>> which is why they are not
> always
>> effective at preventing

>> able to pull their
>>> children from school; those
> that
>> would be forced to
>>> vaccinate would be single
> parents
>> and homes with lower
>>> incomes that depend on the
> school
>> system for childcare. This
