Dear representatives,
I vehemently OPPOSE HB 3063

As a parent I cannot support a bill that takes away the religious, philosophical and personal objections to vaccine exemption for a few reasons:

#1: There have been NO double-blind studies with a placebo control on vaccines. All vaccines were tested against other vaccines with similar ingredients, NOT against a saline-based placebo. This is problematic because it invalidates the studies.

#2: Fetal DNA used in vaccines that were obtained through abortion. This is an ethical and moral issue that I disagree with on a fundamental level.
