

My name is Angie Renick-Hayes and I am an Oregon resident and mother of 8 children some of whom are vaccinated and some are not. I am writing to ask that you absolutely DO NOT pass HB3036 to remove the parental right to eliminate non-medical exemptions for vaccinations. Not only is this morally and infringement of our legal rights, it is downright unconstitutional!

I am not here to debate the issue of safety and vaccinations. I am here to ask for you to preserve the rights of parents to make educated decisions based on their unique children's genetic makeup, background, and health.
