I am taking time out of my day to tell you to <u>OPPOSE HB</u> 3063, the bill to end all non-medical vaccine exemptions for school age children. I believe parents have a right to refuse vaccinations without being coerced. I whole heartedly believe MY BODY, MY CHOICE. No government agency has a right to dictate or mandate what goes into another humans body in pursuit of its own agenda. When there is RISK, there MUST BE A CHOICE.
