

Good Afternoon,

I **oppose** bill HB 3063. Where there is risk, there must be choice. Why I do not vaccinate: I refuse to risk children's health and life by allowing them to be injected with a substance that contains known neurotoxins, carcinogens, and foreign animal and human DNA. A substance that lists chronic illness, brain swelling, paralysis, and deaths as possible reactions; to only "maybe" protect them from diseases that are actually very benign.
