I emphatically oppose HB3063 as violation of personal and parental rights. I see the bill itself as an actual threat to the health, safety and well-being of my children. It is being rushed through to support the interests of one side of the argument. That alone should give legislators pause. The ridiculous notion that only approved doctors can give an exemption shows the true intent of the bills sponsors in taking away our rights as Americans and as parents.
