


Construction Contractors Board Agency Overview

  - > Hiring a permanent director

#### Construction Contractors Board Expenditure History + 2019-21 Governor's Budget




### Construction Contractors Board Revenue Sources



- Agency is 100% Other Funds fee supported
- Licensees currently pay \$250 / biennium, which will continue into 2019-21 (down from \$325 per biennium in 2015-17)
- 2019-21 Revenues:
  - > Licensing Fees \$12.2 million
  - > Fines \$1.6 million
  - > Charges for service \$0.2 million
  - > All Other Sources \$0.1 million
  - > \$1.0 million in fines gets transferred to the General Fund

#### Investments:

- \$259,695 and 1 position (1.00 FTE) to plan for replacing the agency's licensing IT system
- > \$161,122 and 1 position (1.00 FTE) to enhance staffing in the agency's licensing group
- > \$20,406 to reclassify an Accounting Tech 3 to a Fiscal Analyst 1
