Dear Representatives and Senators,

Please forgive the lack of personalization. I've just heard about the hearing tomorrow, and I have only enough time to write my letter and copy everyone in.

I am writing today to request that you do not allow HB 3063 to pass.

In a country that claims equal opportunity for everyone regardless of race, religion, or capacity, this bill is abhorrent. Forcing mandatory vaccinations to access public education not only compromises a right that is at the core of our ability to raise/educate generations of citizens who can maintain the freedom our forefathers and millions of other patriots have fought to protect, it makes it seem that the government believes it owns the physical bodies of its citizens (which sounds like a form of slavery to me and many others).

We moved our small family to Oregon (away from our friends and family) three years ago because mandatory vaccination legislation had just been passed in California, and we refused to subject our son to it.
