I was raised with a natural respect for out of hospital birth and the ability to trust my body. With such an upbringing I found myself attracted to the professional woman who offer and encourage those values in their maternity services.

I have had the incredible experience of working in a free-standing birth center in Lebanon as a billing coordinator for almost four years. During my time working, I have witnessed families struggle to make the difficult decision to choose to birth in an out of hospital setting and accept the complete financial responsibility regardless of the hundreds (if not thousands) of dollars that they paid into a health insurance policy or to accept a location and/or provider not of their choice to avoid the financial burden.
