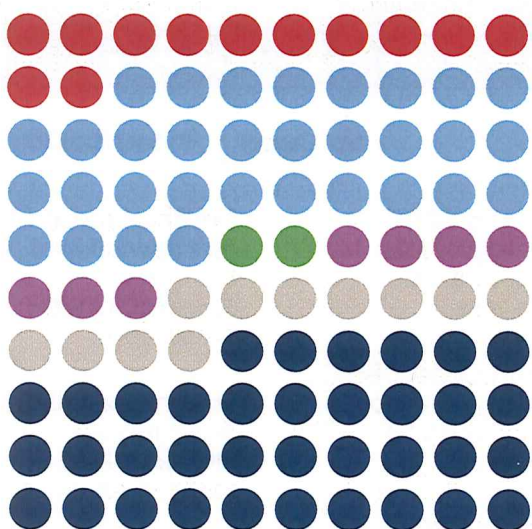


2018 Economic Impact

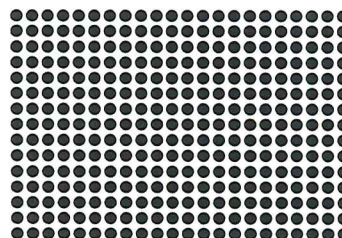
