Impact of Cascade's Rates Resulting from House Bill 2020

Under House Bill 2020, Cascade's residential and commercial customers will see rate increases in their bills by 2021, spiking to a 46% increase by 2035.

Potential Consequence of House Bill 2020

Increased natural gas prices may not even result in the intended carbon reduction. Today's market based electric emissions are relatively high because the generation mix in Bend is not carbon free. This legislation could end up encouraging migration from natural gas, a less carbon intensive fossil fuel, to more carbon intensive sources due to increased utility costs for natural gas customers.
