To the Legislature:

I am contacting you to express my concerns regarding bill HB-3063.

I am a mother of 4 children, 3 grown adult daughters who are mothers themselves now. I have 3 precious grand babies. I also have a 10 year old son

HB-3063 aims to remove a parents right to informed concent.

I believe that the choice of if, when and how a child is to be vaccinated needs to remain between a family and their doctor. Where there is a risk of injury or death, no matter how small the perceived risk may be, there MUST be a choice. To mandate a medical procedure with known risks is medically unethical. I implore you to to consider these critical reasons to oppose or dismiss HB-3063.

Mandatory vaccines are unconstitutional as they are a violation of the 4th and 14th Ammendments; "the right of the people to be secure in their persons"
