Co-Chairs Dembrow and Power and members of the Joint Committee on Carbon Reduction,

My name is Emily, I'm 24 and work for Our Climate, a nonprofit working to mobilize students.

The students I work with are so excited to see this bill moving forward. However, we know as young people that the bill needs to go even further. Our demands are as follows:

- 1. The cap should be lowered to ensure that greenhouse gas emissions from covered entities go to 0 by 2050.
- 2. We encourage the reduction of free allowances in the first year of the program from 100% to 50%. Additionally, we encourage cement, polystyrene, and plastic industries not be eligible for free allowances.
- 3. There must be a specific percentage of investments in impacted communities, as well as a more transparent process that will tie reduction of pollution directly to the use of funds in communities most affected by pollution.
- 4. Incineration of municipal solid waste should not receive an exemption.
