Basically, you're looking to strip down our regulations that are working so well. Please stop.

Our community was poised to become one big hotel town. Where every single property could essentially become a hotel. Our citizens fought back. And will **fight** back again if we need to. We have zoning laws in place to protect us from having every single property become a hotel. And we have a Comprehensive Plan that clearly delineates a primarily residential vision for Gearhart. We have R1, R2, and R3 zones. R1 zones should be protected as residential and not become, in essence, commercial zones.

Please rethink what you are doing. Have you lived next to a short-term rental? You wouldn't wish it on anyone if you did, especially if they were everywhere around you.
