

#### WHAT IS REENGAGEMENT?

WHO DOES REENGAGEMENT SERVE?

Activities, programs, and systems that serve youth who have left school prior to high school graduation or completion

17,506 Oregon youth ages 16-21 with <u>no high school diploma or GED, and not enrolled schoo</u> l
6,401 students <u>left high school</u> in the 2017-18 school year
7,096 youth in the 2017-18 5-year Cohort did not graduate or complete high school
Youth facing barriers that cause disconnection: school climate, academic struggles, behavior issues, health problems, family caregiving, pregancy and parenting, incarceration, trauma
WHAT DOES A REENGAGEMENT PROGRAM DO?
✓ Identifies and removes barriers to education and employment success
Reconnects youth with education, training, and opportunity
Strengthens engagement through personalized options, positive relationships and relevant learning
Supports school completion, credential attainment, and career connection
