

Hello,

I am writing to tell you that I oppose HB 3063, the bill to end all non-medical vaccine exemptions for Oregon school children. I believe every person should have a right to choose for their own family regarding vaccines. It is not a choice that should be given to the government. I also believe every child has the right to an education regardless of their vaccine status.

Only 2.7% of Oregon school children currently hold a philosophical or religious vaccine exemption.

There are many reasons parents use those exemptions. Perhaps their child has had a reaction to a vaccination that doesn't qualify for a medical exemption, and so they choose to not longer use that vaccine, even if they use others. Perhaps they are using a spaced out or using a reduced schedule. They may be a member of a religion (such a Jehovah's Witness), which is morally opposed to the use of vaccination.

There is a lot of gray area that the exemptions allow while still keeping every child healthy.

Furthermore there has never been a true placebo study done to prove vaccines are safe. The only "study" done used a "placebo" which was actually aluminum adjuvant. That is not only unethical; it proves no safety for these vaccines being given to our children at a high rate at a very young age. Vaccines have a range of unsafe ingredients and they are causing harm to children on a regular basis. I do not consent to mandatory vaccination for my children.
