To whom it may concern,

My name is April Ott. I am a mother of two daughters, ages 10 and 7, and I live in Sheridan, Oregon. I am deeply concerned about HB3063 and the potential ramifications on my family.

My youngest daughter was born with cerebral palsy, it is not in her best interest to receive all required vaccines. This bill prevents me from making the decision I feel is best for my daughter's health. I also have the choice to selectively choose how I vaccinate my older daughter and I would lose that basic right as a parent if this bill was to pass.

At this time, It is **VERY** difficult to obtain a medical exemption which I would have to resort to if this bill passed and yet even then it will not cover the vast majority of cases. *Please look into what it takes to get a medical exemption in Oregon.* 

There is no question that some children do not tolerate vaccinations. The National Vaccine Injury Compensation Program would not exist if there wasn't evidence of adverse reactions. It is clearly a violation of parental rights to require people to inject into their children's bodies medical treatments without admitting that there are risks.

My daughter has already been subjected to a lifelong neurological downfall, I do not want to be forced to put her at any further risk. Do not allow this bill to pass and take away that right I have as her parent.
