

To the Legislature:

I am contacting you to express my concerns regarding bill HB-3063.

I don't have any children yet, but I hope to one day have a family. I'd also like to know that any medical choices are my decision and not the governments. I have two younger brothers one who is autistic and I know for a fact he changed after his vaccines. We have autoimmune disease that runs in our family but didn't know it until family members were older and vaccine injured.

HB-3063 aims to remove a parents right to informed consent.

I believe that the choice of if,when and how a child is to be vaccinated needs to remain between a family and their doctor. Where there is a risk of injury or death, no matter how small the perceived risk may be, there MUST be a choice. To mandate a medical procedure with known risks is medically unethical. I implore you to consider these critical reasons to oppose or dismiss HB-3063.

Mandatory vaccines are unconstitutional as they are a violation of the 4th and 14th Amendments;
"the right of the people to be secure in their persons"

If we are not free to make informed, voluntary decisions about which pharmaceutical products we are willing to take, then we are not free in any sense of the word. If this bill passes it will set a very dangerous precedent and there will be no limit on which individual freedoms the state can remove in the name of the greater good. I urge you to view this bill as inhumane and medically unethical. Please
