This is to express my concern over the potential change to the current working law on exemptions. (HB 3063).

This is to let you know that I strongly oppose any changes.

The current law is efficient and working just fine. Please don't let the latest media frenzy and scare tactics change your opinions.

If it is difficult to take into consideration mixed medical opinions (because you both hear pros and cons) please consider logic.

Why are you establishing her immunity only on children? You would not and can not enforce that all people who currently live in OR are truly verified as vaccinated.
