

The AMA has revised and updated their Code of Ethics. However, the provision recognizing a doctor's right to decline immunizations based on non-medical reasons exists unchanged and has been renumbered Opinion No. 8.7 in the AMA code of Ethics.

Medical Doctors give themselves the right to retain non-medical exemptions, while others rights stand to be removed.

Unvaccinated Doctors will be working directly with immuno compromised, elderly, and newborn children. That Unvaccinated Doctors can work directly with the aforementioned but my immuno compromised 6 year old who can't be vaccinated can't attend school with vaccinated children is the ultimate hypocrisy.
