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Hello,

This letter is a request to please oppose bill HB 3063. As a Portland native, I have seen many things change over the years but one thing that must not change is the hearts and minds of Oregonians to have freedom to make medical decisions that best support themselves and their families. Oregon is a special place to call home where people have been innovative and unique and standardizing medicine in such a way would rob this region of what many have worked hard for over the years.

We are seeing an increase in diseases, behavioral problems and symptoms in our children. Families are overwhelmed as it is with how hard everyone works and lives their lives. I have spoken to care givers and educational providers and the changes in students witnessed over the last decade are concerning to them to say the least. Until vaccines have double blind, placebo controlled trials done, as well as research done on multiple vaccine combinations and interaction, it is unethical to remove non-medical exemption. In addition, until human-diploid cells, heavy metals and formaldehyde are removed as the medium cell culture and or adjuvant for vaccines, it is unethical to remove non-medical exemption rights. In addition, the current CDC vaccine schedule should be studied and reevaluated given that since March of 2018, more than 89,000 people have been injured, died or had adverse reactions to the MMR alone. Glutathione and MTHFR are detox pathways that can become compromised in many individuals which leads to genetic susceptibility to be able to detox chemicals and heavy metals- many people already have epigenetic predisposition to these variants and could become vaccine injured without proper knowledge before receiving vaccines. Until clarity and confirmation and resolve is brought to all of these issues, a bill for removing non-medical exemption should be opposed so that families and children can stay safe and still receive an education. Many families I know have children that were injured by vaccines. Please just imagine if this were to happen to your children. To force this onto subsequent children in families that have had this would be traumatic for those parents due to potential genetic components. Trauma, fear and loss permeates society and makes it hard for the collective to progress. Families should have the right to choose what is best for them with their doctor and more medical information and scientific inquiry must be brought forth before a bill like this can be signed into law. The future generations depend on this and deserve for these issues to be explored thoroughly before anything drastic happens.
