RE: African-American/Black Student Success Grant – March 4, 2019

Dr. Darryl Tukufu, Assistant Superintendent of the Office of Equity, Diversity and Inclusion, presented to the Ways & Means Subcommittee on Education on March 4, 2019. During the presentation, the committee asked a question requiring a follow-up. The question and answer are provided below.

## Can you provide a baseline for the number of African American/Black students in Oregon, and where are they located? (Rep. Drazan)

Based on the 2017-2018 school year fall membership, 13,360 out of 578,085 students in Oregon identified as African American or black, which comes out to 2.31 percent of the student population. Below is every school district in Oregon who reported having African American or black students enrolled. Any district not listed reported having zero African American or black students.

The districts that received the African American/Black Student Success Grant witnessed the following impacts:

- 47 percent decrease in disciplinary referrals
- 41 percent decrease in suspensions
- 17 percent decrease in parole or probation violations
- 24 percent decrease of warrants
- 90 percent of students received individual success plans for personal, social, and academic goals.
