As a Parent and a Preschool Teacher I am very concerned about this dangerous bill. I have 4 children and my eldest was fully vaccinated. My youngest has had those that I feel she is in danger of contracting based on where we live, and what she is possibly exposed to. I think as a parent I have the ultimate right to decide what is put in my child's body. I think the burden should be placed on pharmaceutical companies to make vaccines more safe, not on parents who choose not to vaccinate, or wait until their child is a bit older, or wish to create a vaccine schedule that does not expose their child to unnecessary chemicals.

Here is further data to vote AGAINST this BILL:

Mandating Vaccination for ALL students in Oregon for school attendance <u>will impact 31,521</u> <u>students</u> that have filed a non-medical exemption

Exempt in Oregon means the student didn't receive <u>ALL 31 of 31 required</u> vaccines for school attendance.

Oregon has extremely high MMR rates across all counties.

OHA data on high vaccination rates across Oregon.

7.5% of kindergarteners file an exemption form, meaning they could simply be exempt from ONE vaccine and not ALL vaccines.

Only 2.6% of students in K-12 are 100% UNVACCINATED so that means of the people who filed an exemption, 66% of them partially vaccinated their kids! (Because only 2.6% of the 7.5% of exemptions did no vaccines, that means 4.9% did vaccinate, 4.9/7.5=65%)

Exemption rates go up naturally over time as a new vaccine is added to the schedule, parents are opting out until they are ready.
