**Measure Description:**

Authorizes Director of Employment Department to prescribe rules that provide individual may not be excluded from being deemed unemployed solely because of service performed for employing unit under legal compulsion for which individual has not received pay on individual's regular payday.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Employment Department (OED)

**Analysis:**

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Workforce to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure establishes the State Benefits for Federal Workers Fund and appropriates funds to the Employment Department to cover benefits and costs necessary to administer a benefit program that provides state-funded unemployment benefits to certain individuals, including individuals who are an employee of the United States or a member of the Armed Forces of the United States on active duty who are legally compelled to provide regular service without receiving compensation due to lapse of federal appropriations and who would otherwise be eligible for unemployment compensation for ex-service members under federal law.

The measure is anticipated to have an impact on the Employment Department
