My name is Stephen Bomber and I've lived in Portland almost all my life. Portland has managed to maintain it's 'wild places' (I've seen deer and coyotes in my neighborhood), but it's being affected by climate change. We're seeing more snow in the winter, while summers are hotter and drier. The sun has been hidden by smoke from wildfires the past three summers — something that hadn't happened before.
