While I would not argue that we have a global problem with what appears to be a trend toward climate change, HB 2020 puts entirely too much burden on the citizens and economy of Oregon. The proposed Cap and Trade Bill, HB 2020, is a complex piece of legislation that will affect everyone in Oregon for the rest of their lives, especially rural areas in Eastern Oregon.

The economies of rural Oregon, particularly in Eastern Oregon, have been subjected to outside forces that have decimated our citizen's potential to make a living. While these ideas have all been proposed with the best intentions, they have in fact done more damage than good to Oregon's economy and environment.
