Measure Description:

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Department of Administrative Services for purpose of providing financial assistance to state agencies that provide workplace accommodations for employees with disabilities.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Bonding, Department of Administrative Services (DAS), Oregon State Treasurer (OST), Secretary of State (SOS)

Summary of Fiscal Impact:

The bill appropriates \$250,000 General Fund to the Department of Administrative Services.

Analysis:

This measure appropriates \$250,000 to the Department of Administrative Services (DAS) for distribution to state agencies to help cover costs related to providing workplace accommodations for employees with physical disabilities. DAS will distribute grants of between \$2,500 and \$5,000 to state agencies from the Centralized Accommodation Fund which is to be established in the State Treasury. DAS has indicated that costs related to the administration and transfer of funds are minimal and can be absorbed within existing agency resources. The measure has a subsequent referral to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means for further consideration.
