People need restrooms. Even tourists need public restrooms. Nobody should be required to buy a coffee to use a restroom in the city or on a road trip. Whether the restroom should be free or cost, say, 50 cents, we need more access to restrooms. Drinking fountains are readily accessible, so why not toilets? Do not criminalize an essential bodily function. Nobody wants to pee on the sidewalk or poop in the bushes; they do it out of necessity.
