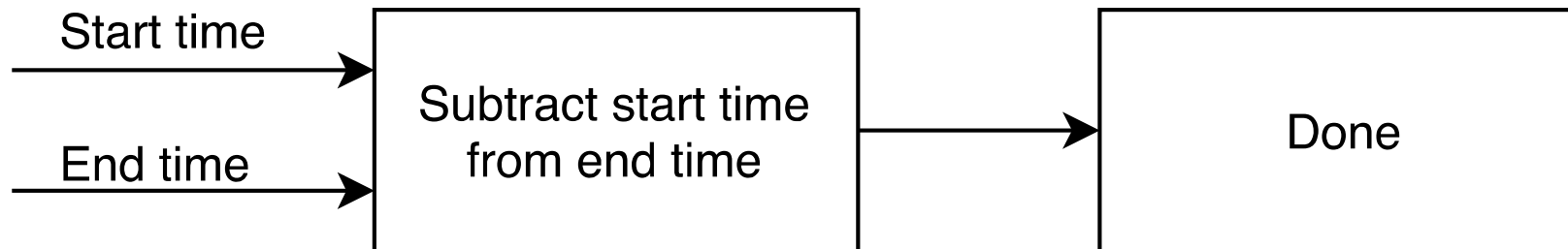

accounting for clock shifts



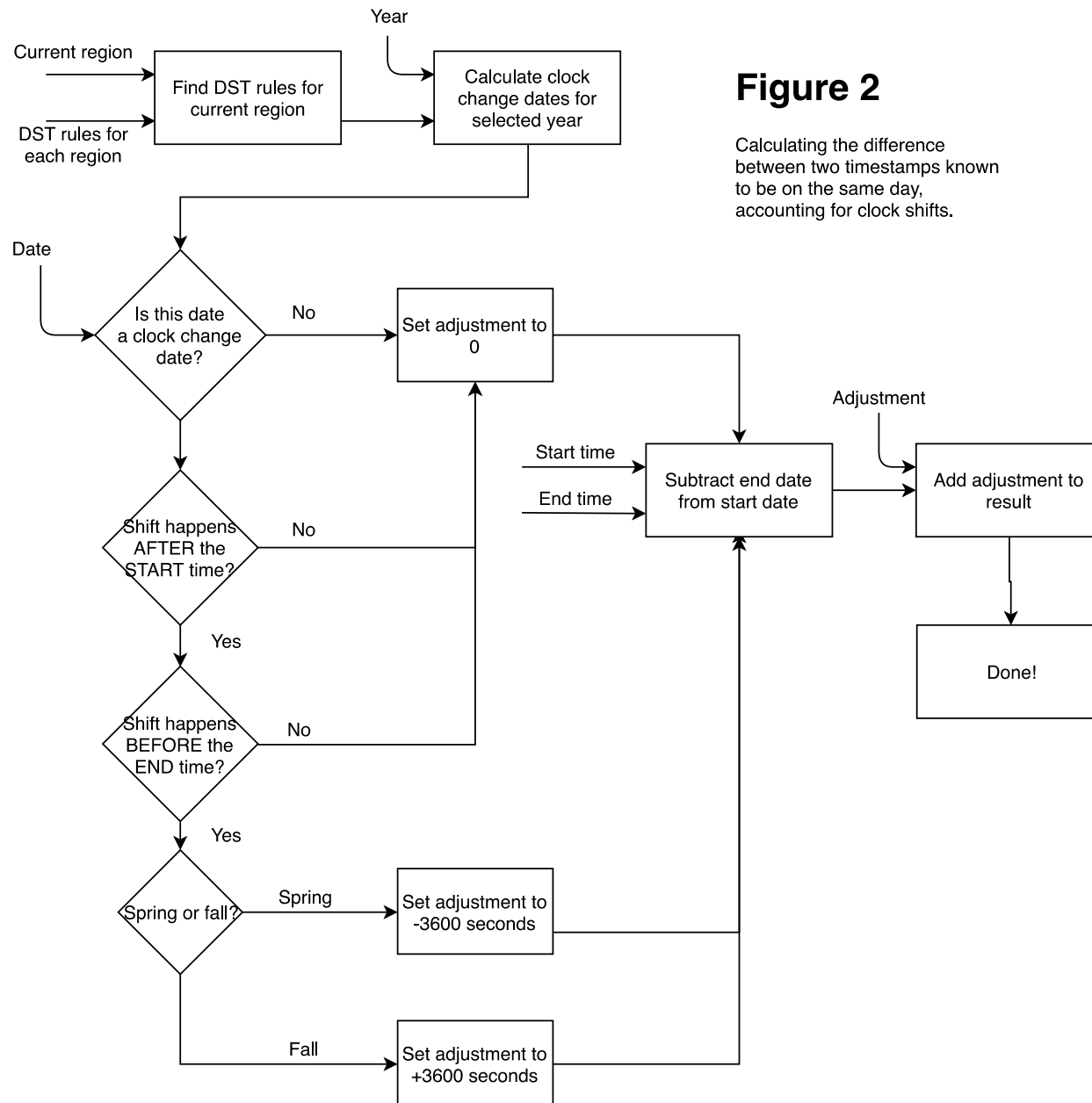
