

Dear members of the House Healthcare committee,

I have some reservations about this bill as it stands due to the following questions:

- which vaccines and age groups are intended?
- will dentists have extra training to administer as well as be able to recognize vaccine reactions?
- will they require special informed consent forms to be signed?
- who will be liable for possible injury and will this affect their insurance?
- will dentists have the capabilities for storage facilities as vaccines require special handling ?
- I can't imagine my kids liking to go to the dentist if it becomes routine to be asked about whether or not we want a vaccine as they are already nervous about their twice yearly visits.
- Will Dentist's start firing patients who decline their offer of vaccines?
- how will they tie into the states Alert system to make sure double vaccination doesn't occur?
