


# Child abuse is common

- 676,000 children each year in U.S.
  - -1,700 fatalities

- 11,077 children each year in Oregon
  - -30 fatalities



#### Medicaid High Utilizers (Pathways to Health Study)

Providence Health & Services Center for Outcomes Research and Education (CORE)

**30%** suffered repeated physical, sexual or emotional abuse in early childhood

22% had unmet basic needs (food, clothing)

13% lived with an adult with a substance use issue

17% were separated from their parents

30% were arrested or incarcerated at some point

52% were substance users

26% were homeless

28% were separated from their children

0-6 years old

7-19 years old

63% had experienced abuse by age 19 19-30 years old

30+ years old

**50%** dropped out of school

28% ran away or left home early

30% became teen parents

15% became homeless at some point

46% were substance users


40% struggle with mental health

**70%** describe struggling to get needed healthcare


30% describe being socially isolated

None are able to work






# Oregon CAICs are part of a national movement that includes 880 CACs\*

# CAICs served 7,895 children last year

39% of children served were 0-6


37% of children served were 7-12








## **Highly-specialized care**
