

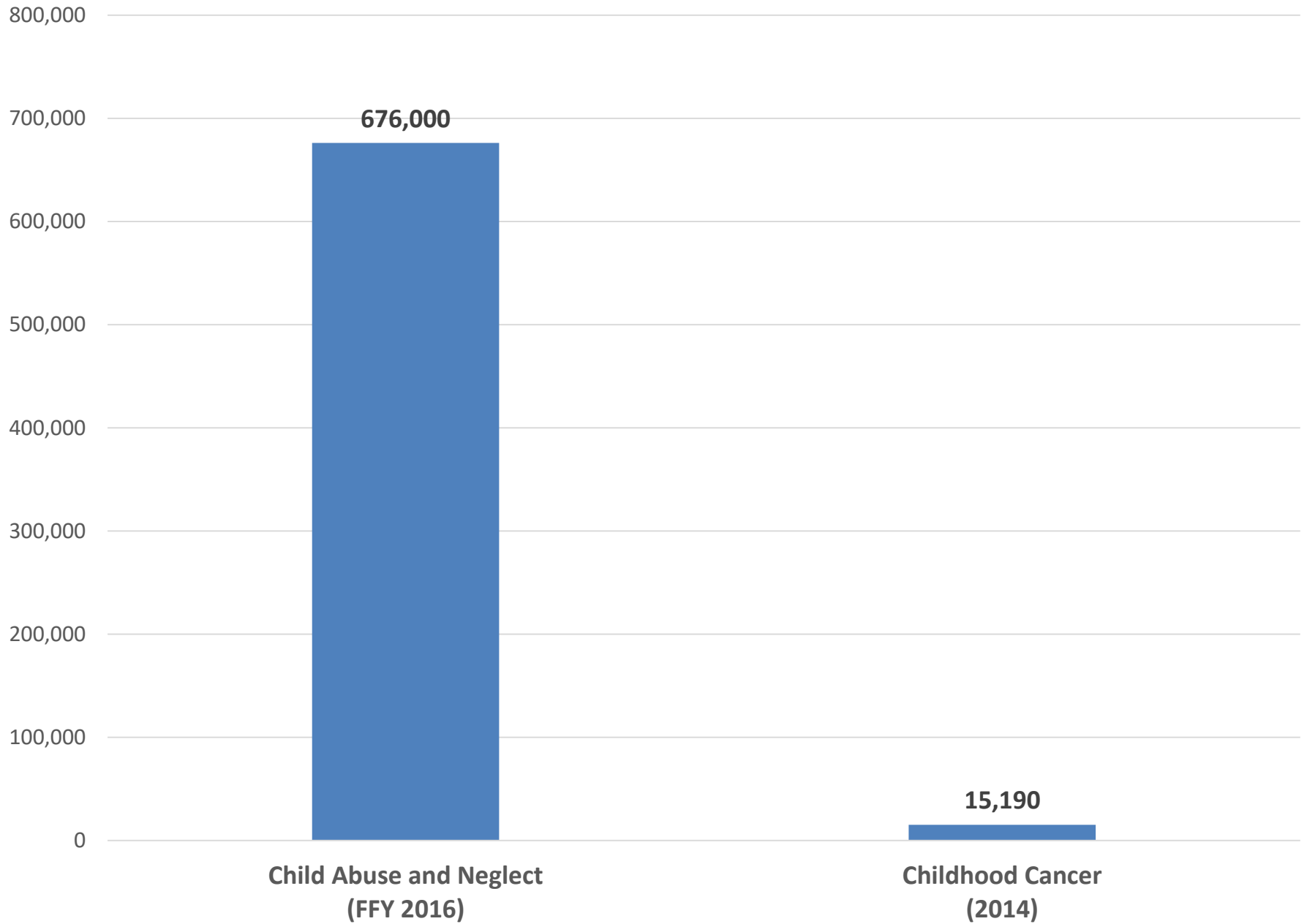

# Child abuse is common

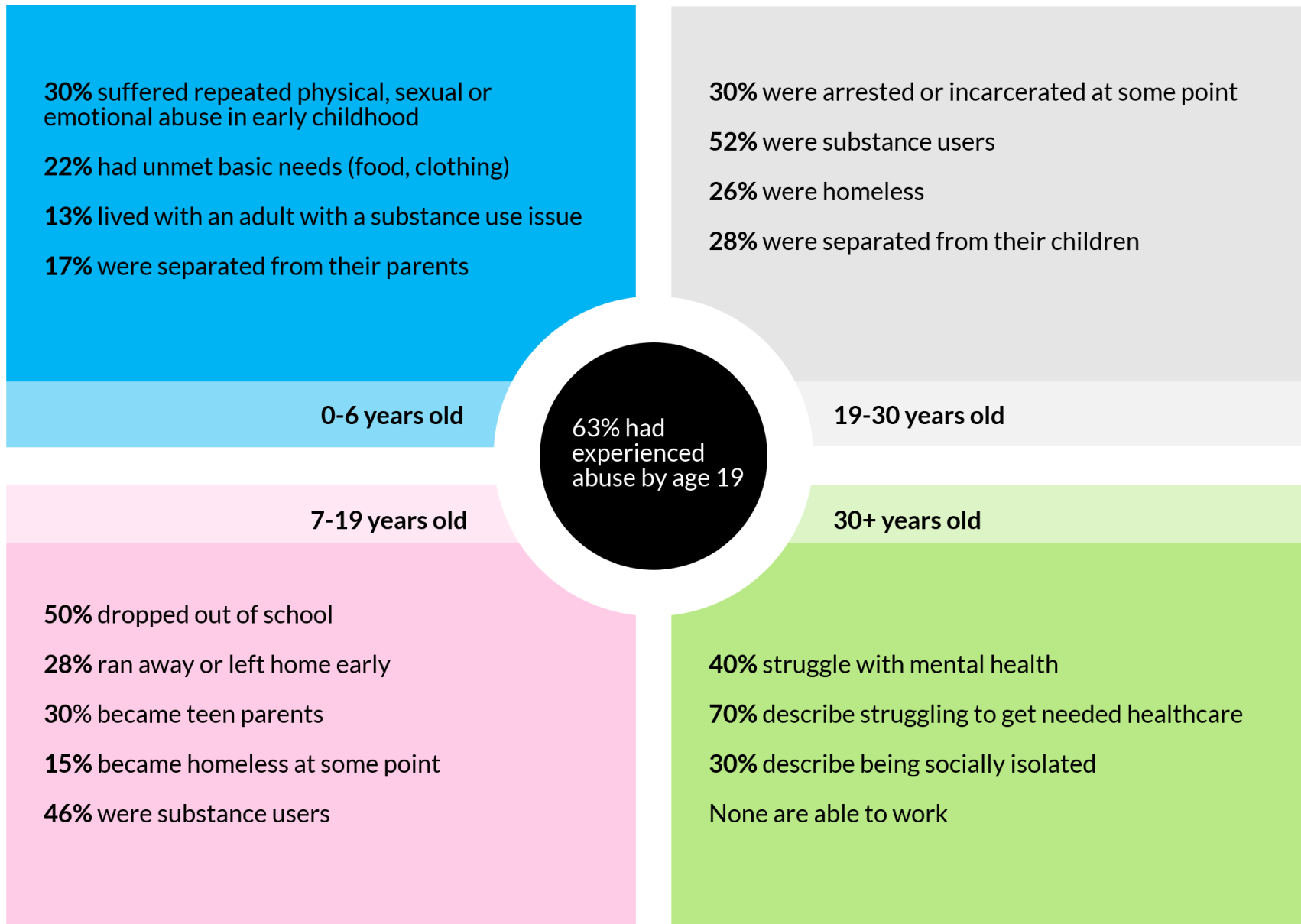


- 676,000 children each year in U.S.
  - 1,700 fatalities
- 11,077 children each year in Oregon

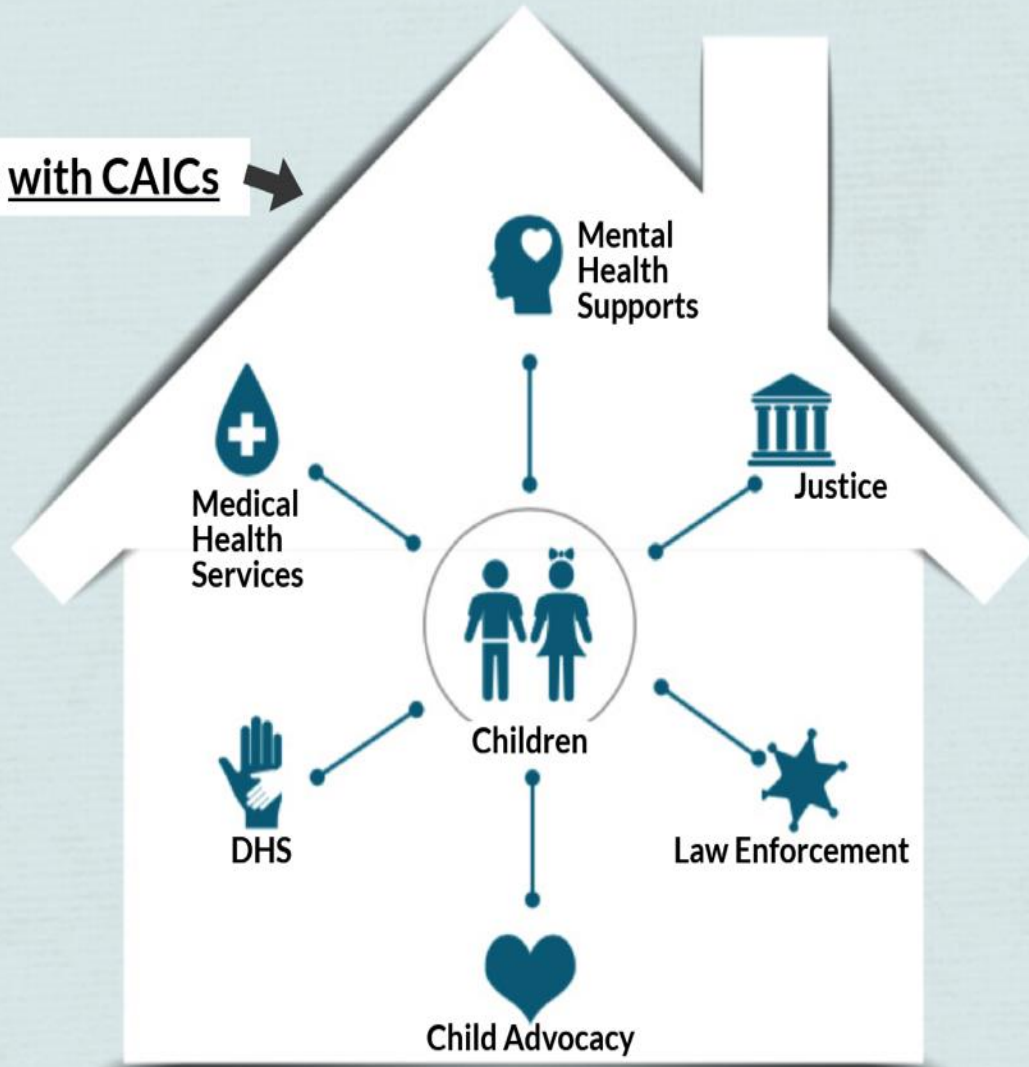
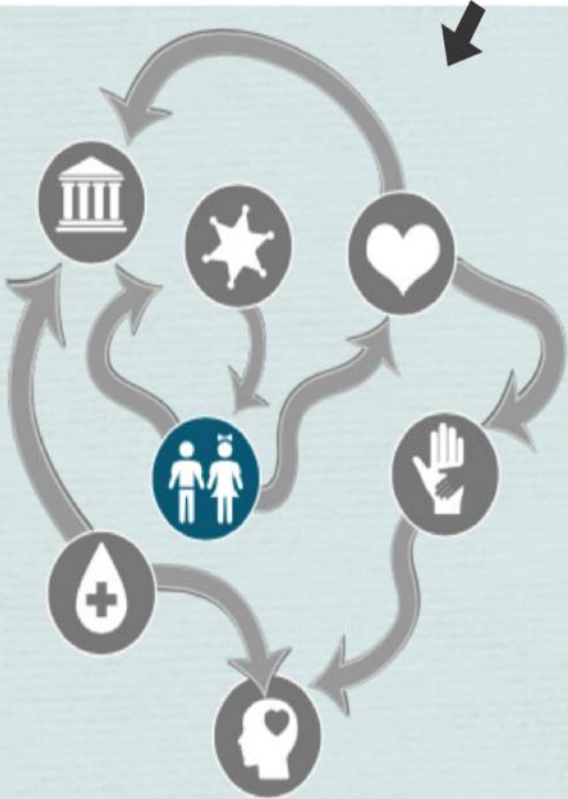

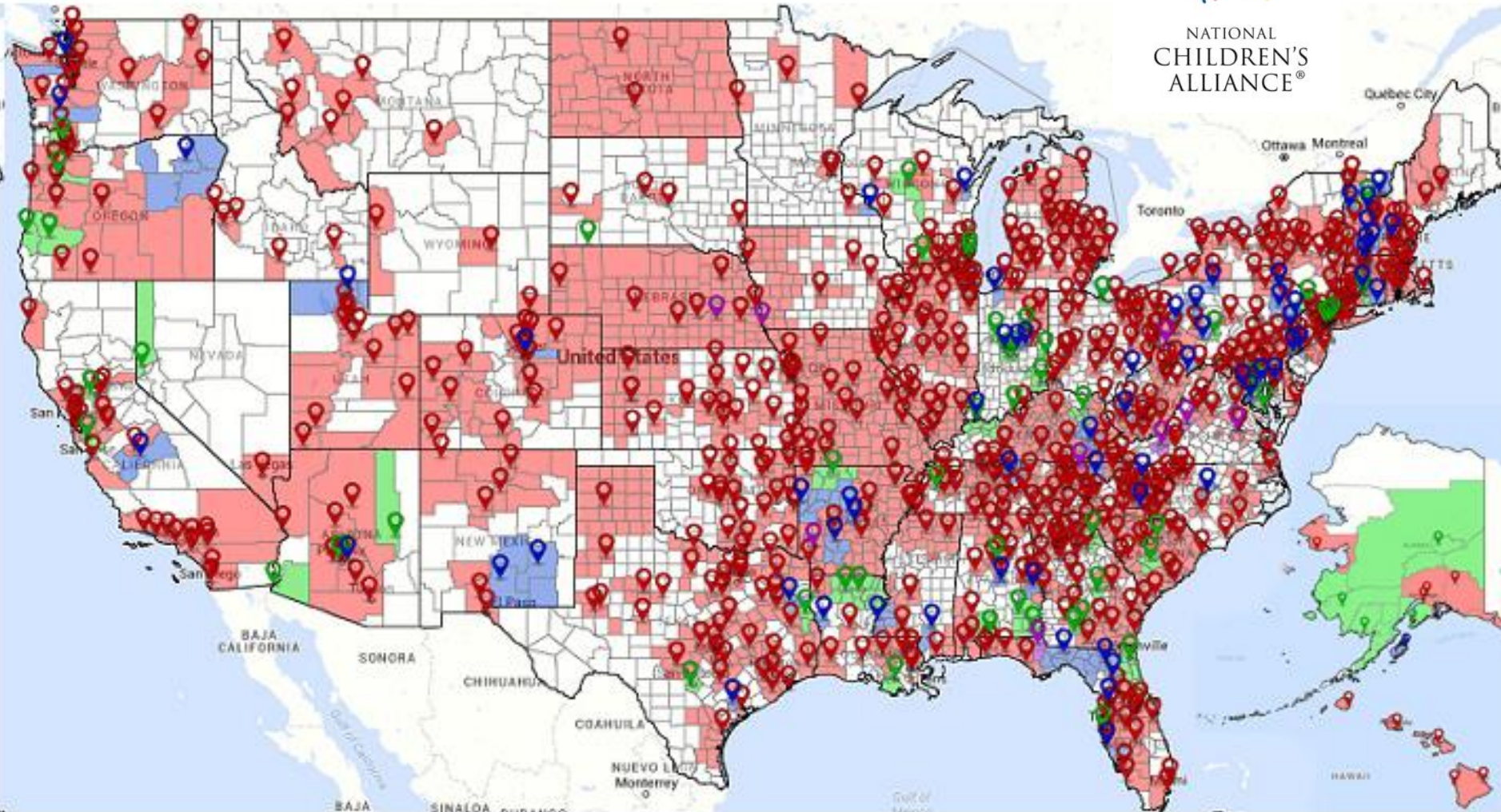
Child abuse response without CAICs versus with CAICs



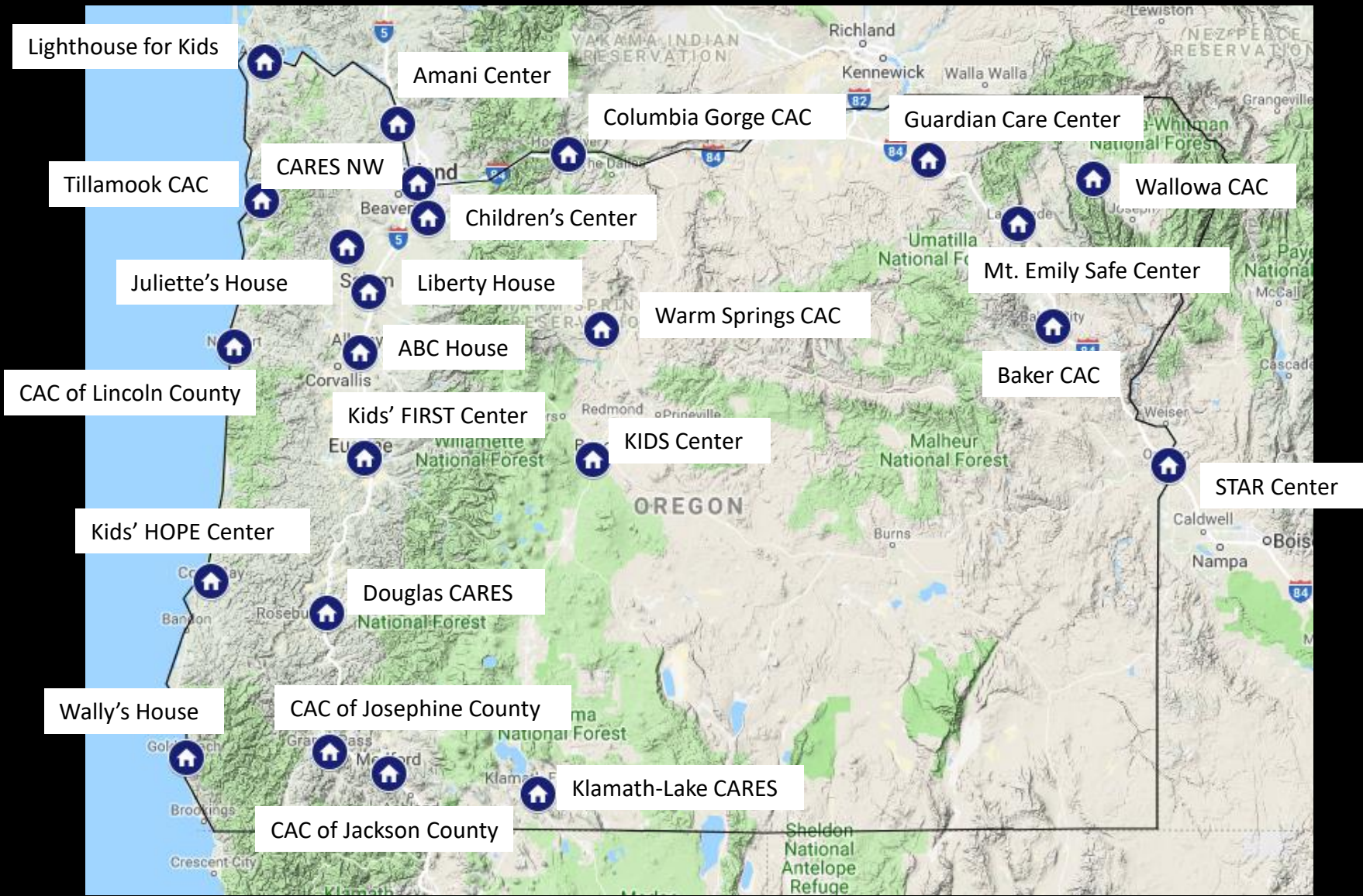
# Oregon CAICs are part of a national movement that includes 880 CACs\*

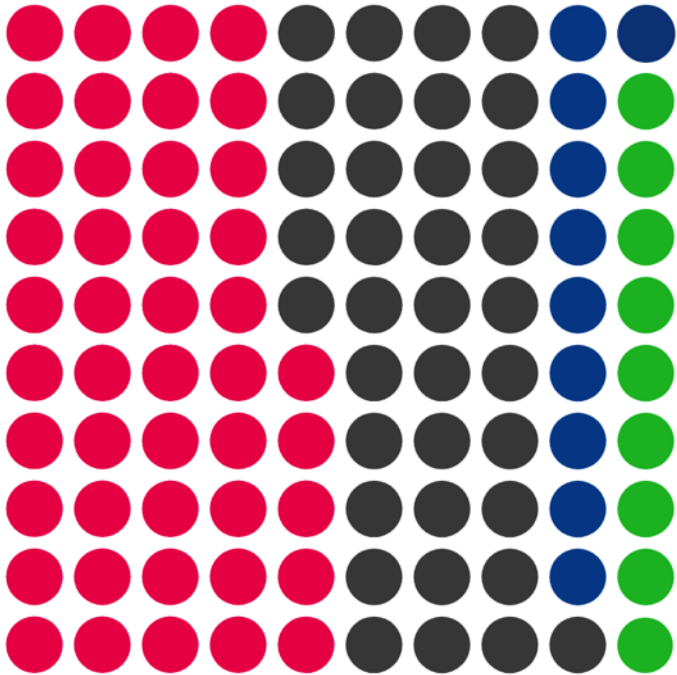

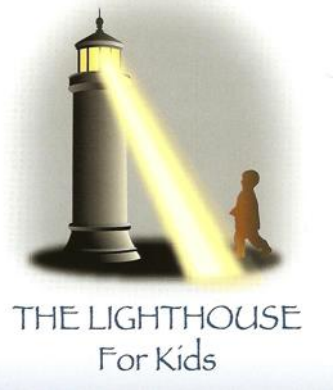
