As a life-long Oregonian raising her four children here, and coming from a family of multi-generational Oregonians, I stand in opposition to HB3063 and urge you to do the same. This is not a pro/anti issue. The issue with HB3063 is that it infringes on our human rights, including violating the 1st Amendment of the Constitution. No one should want to hand over to the government their right to freedom of religion, free education, medical freedom, bodily autonomy, and informed consent.

Let's not be like our neighboring state to the South who's pertussis cases have almost doubled since 2016, when they passed a bill similar to Oregon's HB3063.
