

- Expand list of medical conditions approved for exemption to any and all serious reactions to vaccinations listed by the CDC on [https://www.cdc.gov/vaccines/hcp/acip-recs/general-recs/contraindications.html?CDC\\_AA\\_refVal=https%3A%2F%2Fwww.cdc.gov%2Fvaccines%2Frecs%2Fvac-admin%2Fcontraindications.htm](https://www.cdc.gov/vaccines/hcp/acip-recs/general-recs/contraindications.html?CDC_AA_refVal=https%3A%2F%2Fwww.cdc.gov%2Fvaccines%2Frecs%2Fvac-admin%2Fcontraindications.htm), as well as any and all moderate reactions that may be predictive of future, more serious reactions.

- Authorize and require the development of a training course on how to recognize serious reactions to vaccines, as well as moderate reactions that may be predictive of vaccine injury upon future vaccination. Require any and all personnel who are authorized to administer vaccines to complete this course within 3 months of this law taking effect. Require all authorized personnel to report any and all moderate and serious vaccine reactions to VAERS and OHA within one week of their occurrence.
