Acceptance of a delayed or spaced out vaccine schedule as long as communicable illnesses vaccines are being administered. Submitting delayed schedule to school and allowing them to check in to assure schedule is being followed. This allows vaccines to be spaced out so our children are not being injected with so many questionable ingredients and neurotoxins in such a short amount of time, while protecting public health concerns by assuring communicable disease vaccines are being administered.

Medical exemption granted to families who show are at higher risk of severe adverse reactions. This would allow the child to be protected BEFORE any damage has occurred.

Current required vaccines only, keeping future vaccines such as HPV and FLU as recommended and not required
