I am asking if a delayed vaccine schedule be considered as acceptable for entry to school.

A delayed schedule still includes being vaccinated against communicable diseases but at a safer pace. By safer I mean not being exposed to so many heavy metals/neurotoxins so close together. My son is 18 months old and currently unvaccinated. After doing some more research I feel like I could be comfortable vaccinating my son at a slower pace but still safe for public health.
