Amendment proposal for HB 3063

If the bill must progress to the Senate, I propose the following be added to it.

1. An education course regarding adverse reactions to vaccines should be given to all health care provider who administer vaccines. Also included should be first responders and emergency room staff.
2. Religious freedom should be granted.
3. A waiting period should be mandated for all persons contagious to the infectious diseases. This should include a 30 day exclusion period from schools and daycares for persons recently vaccinated, as live virus vaccines shed (spread) the disease.
4. A separate system for adverse reactions should be created for Oregonians with adverse reactions. The federal system is not working, effective or reliable at its intended purpose. The educational course would include how workers would report to the Oregon Adverse Event Reporting System.
