

1. Rep. Drazen asked if a child could get a Med exemption based on family history. OHA incorrectly stated that not if child's sibling or parent has immune issues, only child himself. This is opposite of what CDC says. Under MMR, MMRV, Varicella contraindications:

- **Has a parent, brother, or sister with a history of immune system problems.**

Some people should not get this vaccine

Tell your vaccine provider if the person getting the vaccine:

- **Has a history of seizures, or has a parent, brother, or sister with a history of seizures.**
- **Has a parent, brother, or sister with a history of immune system problems.**

AND CDC contraindicates child from receiving live vaccines together:

Who Should Not Get MMR, MMRV, Varicella Vaccines

- **Has gotten any other vaccines in the past 4 weeks.** Live vaccines given too close together might not work as well.
