I am writing to request your support of legislation that is critical to our short line railroad, Goose Lake Railway, and the businesses we serve in Lake County. The Short Line Railroad Maintenance Tax Credit (HB 2978) is legislation that provides a critical infrastructure funding solution that will allow short line railroads to increase investments in upgrading track and bridges to better serve our customers in Oregon.

Goose Lake Railway operates approximately 55 miles of track in Oregon and we provide freight service to customers transporting a variety of commodities that help feed, clothe, supply and power homes and businesses across Oregon, the United States, and beyond.
