I am president of a non-profit organization (Coalition Advocating for Animals (CAFA)) that rescues and adopts cats/kittens in the Salem area. All cats/kittens that are rescued by CAFA are stray and/or abandoned. CAFA supports SB 638 and would be a participant in rescuing cats released from research laboratories so that we could find homes and get them adopted.
