We have been loyal customers of Critter Cabana Newberg and Wilsonville for 15 years. Critter Cabana is an integral part of the community. We have adopted three dogs from Critter Cabana over the years. We chose to adopt through Critter Cabana because we trust the owners and their business choices. Our first dog was a pug we named Morsel. The staff at Critter Cabana are very knowledgeable about the puppies they sell. Banning puppy sales at Critter Cabana will not stop puppy mills... it will only hurt families who want the community infrastructure to facilitate responsible pet ownership.
