

Hello Representatives,

I am writing to you in support of fighting against HB3063. I am a father of one child. My wife and I are extremely concerned about this Bill "FORCING" The People OUR People in our society to take unnecessary measures to families based on "Fear", but not "FACTS".

My wife and I have not allowed our 3-year old to have any vaccinations-YET, he will hopefully someday, but he has many food and chemical sensitivities and is prone to illness-and due to his genetic risk factors. We have been advised by multiple doctors of the risk of him receiving his vaccine, because of his genetic risk factors and thus this should not be a reason to legally prevent him from attending school. Please remember that like with all medications some people may have had a poor reaction or adverse reactions or even may have a very high risk of an adverse reaction due to established allergies or sensitivities or genetic factors that make it unsafe to receive vaccinations at all. My wife and I still plan to have our 3-year old vaccinated, but on a modified schedule recommended by 2 doctors. One is his primary pediatrician, and another is a physician whom specializes in children autism.

I ask that all the facts and testimonies regarding the pros and cons of receiving vaccinations is evident and presented to the public for education, so families can have a "CHOICE". I am not saying that vaccination is bad. However, we must investigate it more and be more educated of the risk rather than react to "Fear".
