

Hello Representatives,

I am writing to ask that you vote NO on HB 3063. This bill would deny my daughter and future children to their right to an education.

There is NO decline of vaccine rates. MMR rates remain high. There is NO emergency. Stats are attached.

We DO vaccinate our daughter and ourselves. However, we do not consent or believe in giving certain vaccines. Where there are questions about safety, effectiveness, or necessity, among them, the Flu, HPV, Hepatitis B until teenage years, rotovirus or chickenpox vaccines. Mandatory vaccination is completely against many of our rights as US citizens, our religious freedoms, our philosophical freedoms, and our medical freedoms and rights to education.

Until they know what causes some people to be injured or killed by vaccines, we aren't willing to blindly follow orders or coercion. The full schedule has NEVER been tested for safety in its entirety. They do not even study the possibilities regarding Carcinogenic, fertility, or mutagenic outcomes, for a single vaccine, and every vaccine insert states this fact.

These are great risks, and the decisions are up to us and our Dr, to weigh OUR medical histories and make informed decisions and give consent. Where there are risks, there MUST be choice. Many argue medical exemptions for those who need them. Unfortunately, these are extremely narrow criteria, and often those who need them are denied them.

Passing this bill will not result in any increase in vaccines in our family, or thousands of others.

There is no drop in MMR vaccine percentages, over 96% for K-12. This is a FACT. We still have higher rates needed for "herd immunity." The current system IS working. We do not need unconstitutional laws to force families into choosing school, or coerced medical procedures. The media is doing its job beautifully, which is twisting the truth, to create fear and panic where there isn't anything to fear.

It's not about pro vax or anti vax.

This is about our rights. No one has the right to take away my rights. We are not anti vaccine. We are not antiscience. We are not anti medicine or faith healers. We are pro health and pro life and pro freedom.

When our family is sick, we stay home. Unfortunately, I know many families who send their sick kids to school because they can't afford to stay home. How far can this possibly go when we open the door to this kind of violation? Will adults be forced to catch up on dozens of vaccines that came about since we were children? Will we continue to be punished and discriminated against for having freedom over our bodies? Will organ donation be mandatory in the future? Chipping people? Forced cancer treatment?

My healthy, disease free, child, is not endangering other vaccinated children, or immunocompromised people, when she doesn't carry any diseases.

Just as children with AIDS, Hep B, Hep C, Hep A, and countless others diseases are entitled to an education, so are my children, regardless of their vaccine status.

If we don't reject this bill, my family will be forced to leave a home we love, and the people we love, in order to go somewhere that protects us, rather than discriminate toward us. We will take our tax dollars and our businesses to a state, or country if it comes to that, that protects our rights that this country was founded upon.

In California, a whooping cough outbreak has occurred in a college where only those effected, we vaccinated. None of the medically exempt students, were infected
