HB 2224 - STRONGLY OPPOSE

This bill establishes a grant program for improving student outcomes by supporting social, emotional, mental and physical health needs of students.

I note that all the testimonies supporting this bill have a vested monetary interest with a big dollar sign on their foreheads. This is a set up. Schools lack the resources to address emotional and mental problems because you have cut their counseling staff. So now a big tag of \$85 million is asked to make up for that mistake? This is a high cost substitute for counselors without the proper training and with no direct individual help.

Social-emotional development is the ability for children to form relationships and manage emotions by recognizing one's own feelings and the feelings of others.
