I had my children in the 1960s and not much has changed for Paid Family and Medical Leave since then. I was working as a public health nurse, in Minnesota, before I relocated to Oregon. My husband was attending law school at the time and I was the breadwinner. I became pregnant and had to take off 3 months of work, unpaid. I was extremely fortunate for those unpaid 3 months, but it was difficult to manage no income with a newborn baby.
