WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Adjusts punctuation in statute by adding in ORS 412.029, the last sentence, a comma after the word "payments" and before the word "as."

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

Currently ORS 412.029 reads, "Each money payment of aid made to a representative payee or to a guardian or a conservator under ORS 412.026 or 412.028 shall be expended by the representative payee, guardian or conservator solely to make purchases to meet the needs of the individuals with respect to whom the payment is made. However, the individuals may receive from the representative payee, guardian or conservator such portions of the money payments and at such intervals as may be permitted by rules adopted by the Department of Human Services."
